PART C

STATE POLICY FOR THE SUPPLY OF WATER FROM STATE PIPELINES

1. Applications for water connections on State pipelines will be considered only within the framework of the capacity of the relevant waterworks, as a whole, and in terms of the policy as laid down and approved.
2. In terms of the said policy water supply from such connections will only be considered, if technically possible, if
 - 2.1 the existing water sources on the property are insufficient or non-potable for domestic purposes.
3. When considering an application the following will *inter alia* apply:
 - 3.1 The applicant must enter into a formal water supply agreement with the Municipality of Windhoek.
 - 3.2 A connection fee and water tariff are payable in conformity with approved financial directives.
 - 3.3 The connection will only be provided to the boundary off the servitude of the water system. The applicant shall be responsible for the transportation of water from this point and for providing pressure and leak-proof storage facilities if required.
 - 3.4 The Municipality of Windhoek must be satisfied that the applicant will be able to meet the financial responsibilities attached to the connection.
 - 3.5 The Municipality of Windhoek must be satisfied that the provision of a connection will not result in any malpractice or destruction of the soil, or is not in conflict with government policy in respect of regional – or national planning.
 - 3.6 No water will be provided for irrigation purposes, unless a water scheme was specifically erected for irrigation.
4. Applications for connections for industrial and mining purposes will be considered on merit.
5. Applications for connections for construction purposes will be considered on merit.
